Course Description: LIUNA Training and Education Fund developed a Pipeline Safety for Construction Crafts program. This program can be broken down into various modules/segments. The activities covered in the “Back End Pipeline Work” module are considered the final stages of completing the pipeline project. These activities include cleaning up and restoring the right-of-way and testing the pipeline. The Laborers Training School has incorporated this module into the 40 hour Pipe Laying course.

Objectives

- Describe cleanup procedures that are necessary on pipeline projects.
- Identify and describe the purpose of the “pig” that is used for pipeline construction.
- Describe the procedures for pigging pipe.
- Explain the purpose of pressure testing pipe.
- Define the term “composite crew” as it relates to pipeline construction and explain what it does.
