Course Description: LIUNA Training and Education Fund developed a Pipeline Safety for Construction Crafts program. This program can be broken down into various modules/segments. The activities covered in the "Front End Pipeline Work" module consist of understanding pre-job preparation, surface grading, hustle skids, assisting surveyors, welders and single side boom operators, coating pipe, excavating, testing for leaks and landscaping. The Laborers Training School has incorporated this module into the 40 hour Pipe Laying course.
