Signal Person Syllabus

Time: 16 hours

Maximum Class Size: 12

Prerequisites: Taught in conjunction with the Hoisting & Rigging Course

Course Description:

This 8-hour LIUNA Training and Education course is a part of the Hoisting & Rigging program. It introduces the responsibility of a signal person, situations that warrant the use of a signal person, and communicating with the operator. Students will learn how to perform at least 15 crane hand signals and will demonstrate the ability to communicate with the operator by using clear and precise voice commands.

Goals/Objectives/Student Learning Outcomes:

- Describe common errors that cause most crane and rigging accidents
- Describe and demonstrate six safe work practices for working with and around cranes and explain why each is important
- Identify at least three different types of cranes
- Using scenarios involving cranes working near power lines, give the minimum clearance between crane and the lines based on OSHA standards
- Describe and demonstrate five safe work practices related to rigging and hoisting
- Identify seven types of rigging hardware and describe the function of each piece of hardware
- Describe eight types of sling configurations and identify the situations in which each are used
- Describe the effect that the sling angle has on slings and hardware
- Describe the three situations that warrant the use of a signal person
- Describe five responsibilities of a signal person
- Describe the methods of communicating with an operator
- Describe two essential practices a signal person should do before signaling and the importance of each.
- With the commands for hand signals available, correctly perform at least 15 crane hand signals
- Demonstrate the ability to communicate with an operator by using clear and precise voice commands
